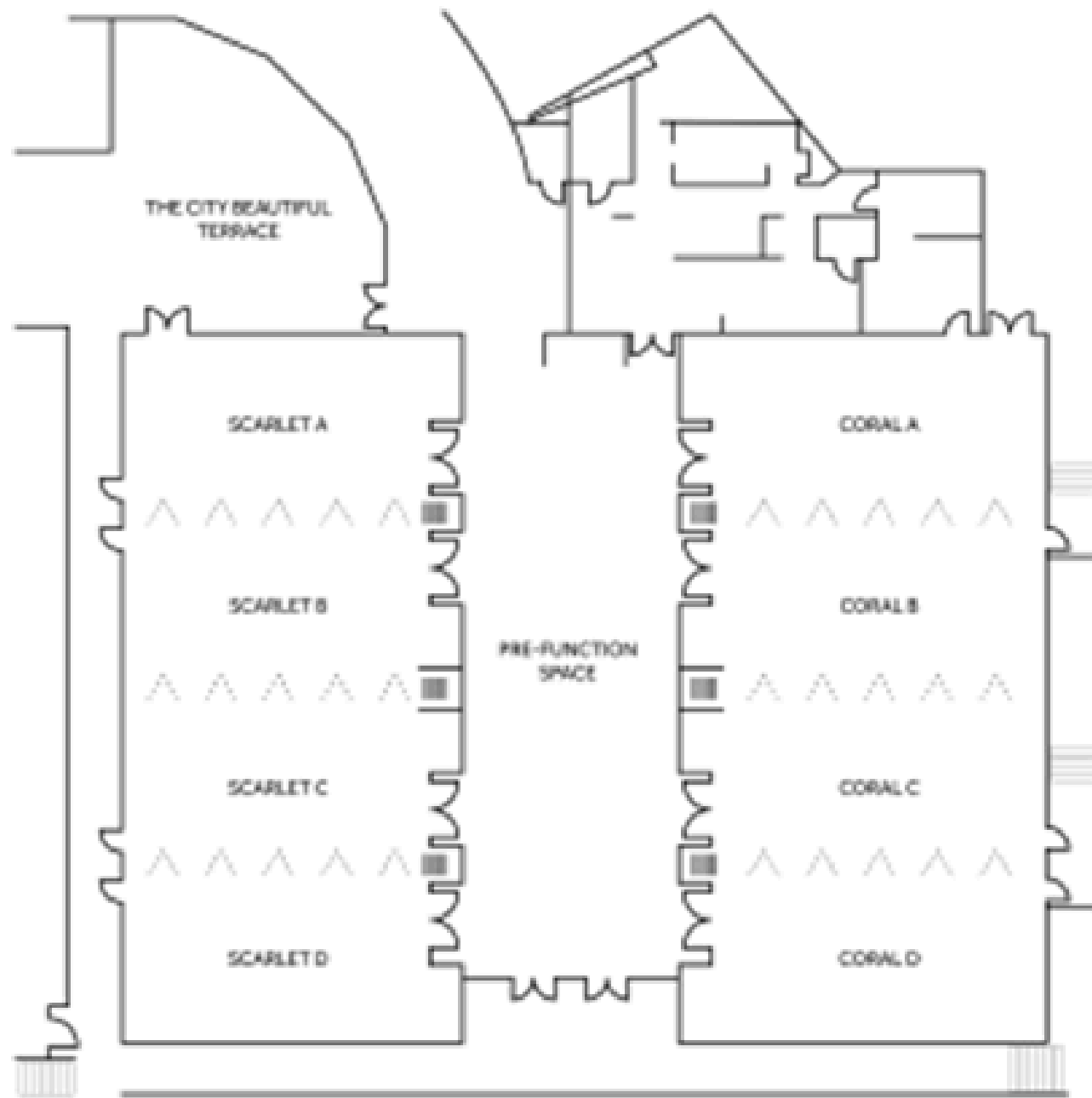

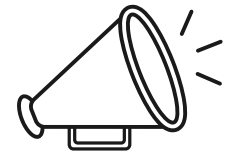

# HYDRATION AND HEAT

You need MORE water at high heat.

- Proper hydration is vital in high heat to support the body's cooling system, which relies on sweating.
- Drink water consistently, even before feeling thirsty.
- Severe dehydration can lead to heat exhaustion or heat stroke, showing symptoms like dizziness, nausea, and confusion.

How much extra?

- 1 to 1.5 liters of water daily.
- This means you should aim for a total of 3 to 4 liters of fluids per day (101 to 135 oz.)

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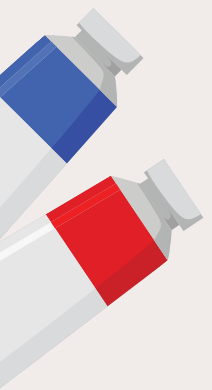

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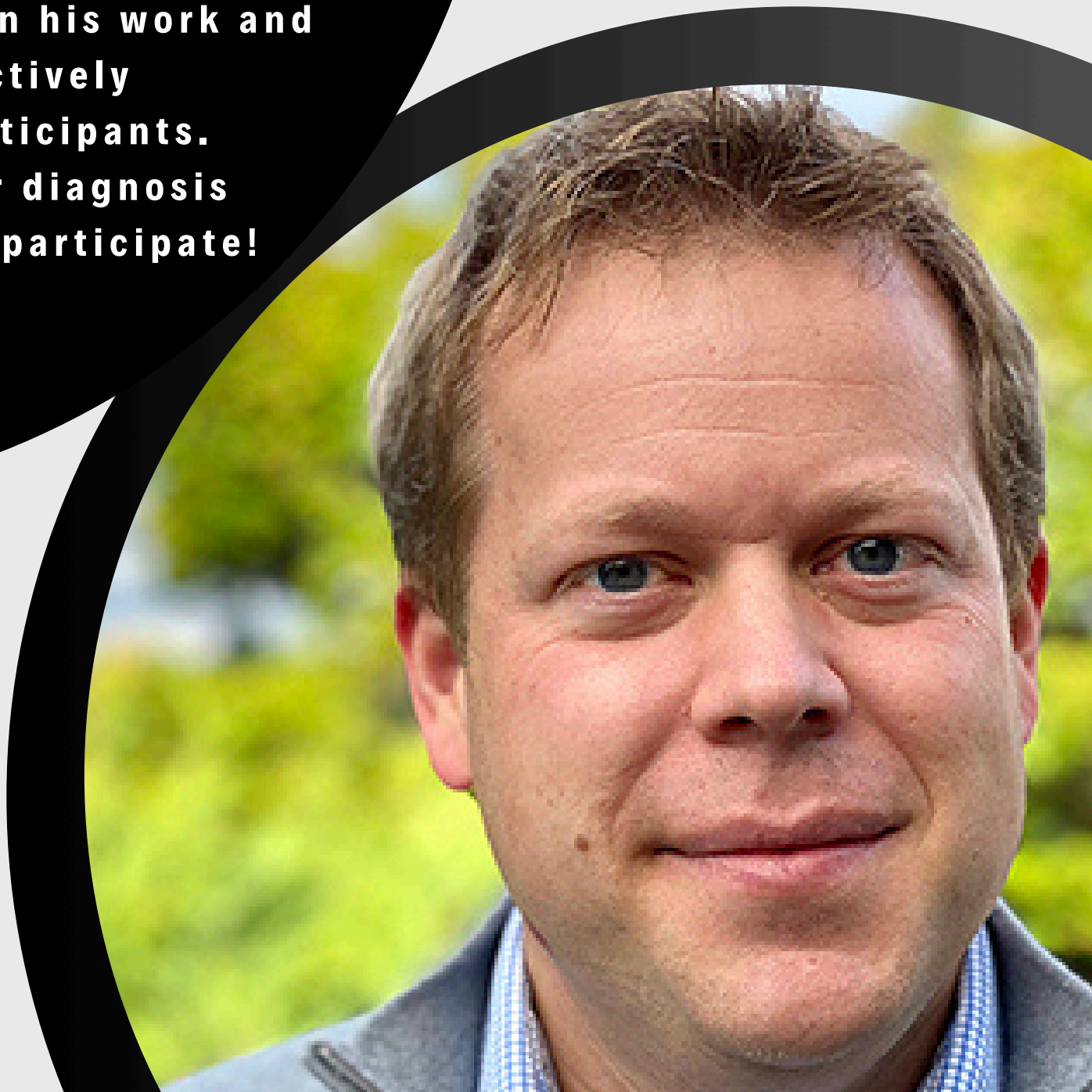
# DR. MILLER

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# DR. ALEXIS BANCROFT

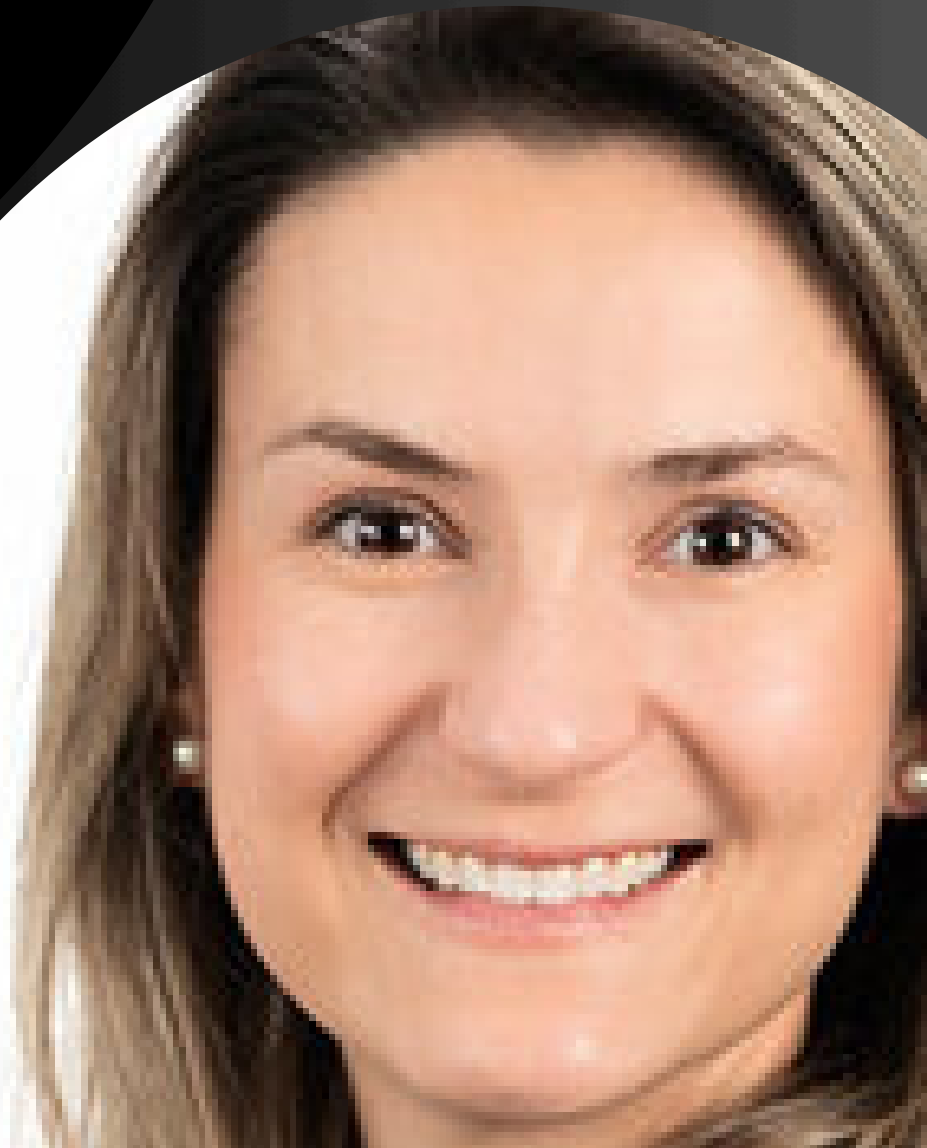

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# ANGELA TYSZKA

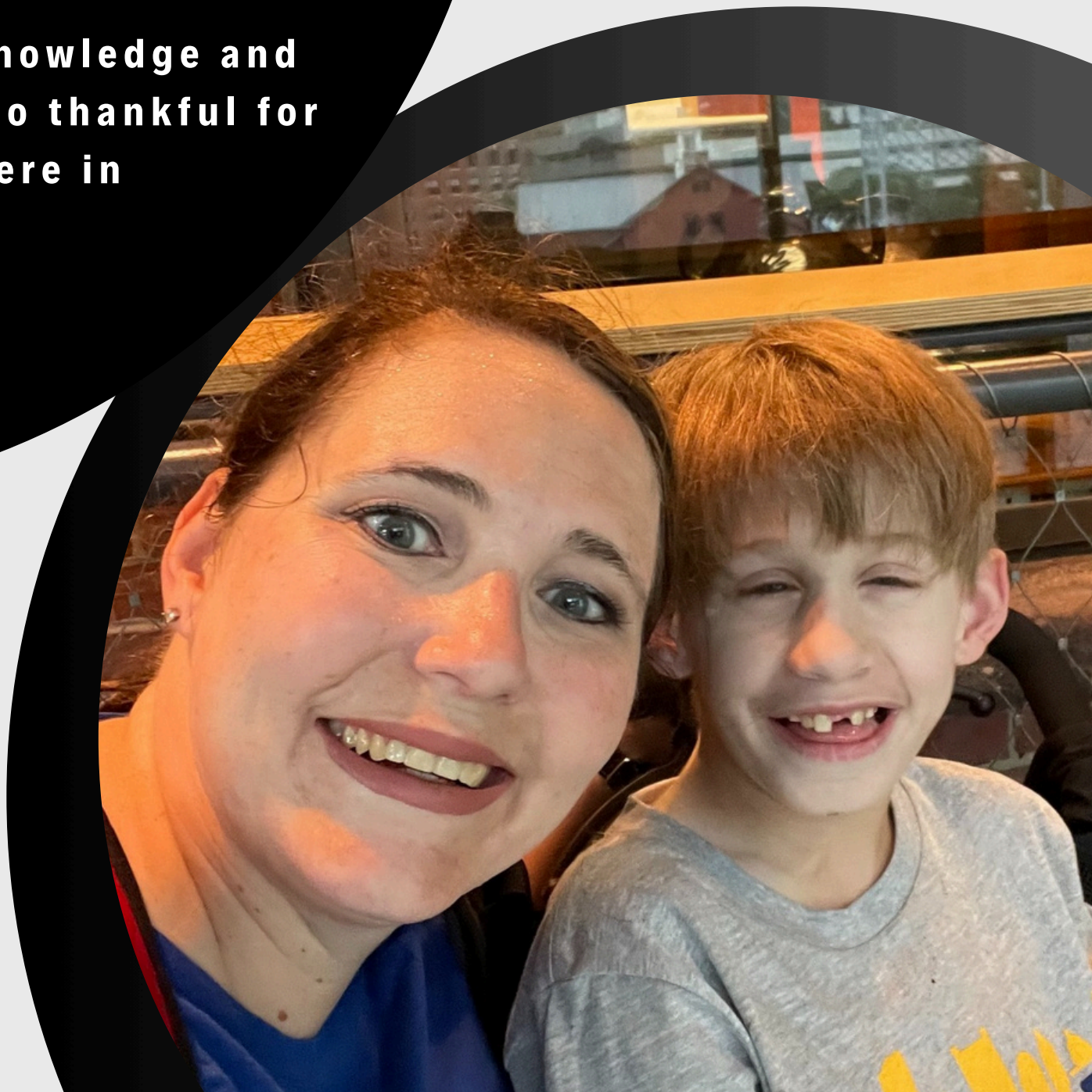
